We look to the local community to help our mission; in kind donations as well as supplies are much needed. We are staffed by many dedicated volunteers who care for the animals and many of them are cancer survivors.

The mission of Antler Ridge Wildlife Sanctuary is to provide care and treatment to sick, injured or orphaned wild animals. To actively educate the public to care for the ecosystems and support the environment in which they live and the wildlife they share it with.
